Starting June 10, 2020 at 7:00am, Wagoner Community Hospital's visitation restrictions and policies are changing. We understand these temporary changes in policy have been, and will continue to be, difficult for both patients and families. However, our patients are highly susceptible to contract infections from outside sources. In an effort to protect our vulnerable resident population we are limiting visitors until further notice.

## What Visitors and Guest Can Expect

- Masks and social distancing are encouraged
- All visitors must be 18 years of age or older, exceptions will be made for pediatric appointments
- Visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms
- Anyone experiencing symptoms or those with known exposure to COVID-19 in the past 14 days are not allowed to visit.

## Visitor Restrictions – Adult Patients

- Adult Hospitalized patients are allowed one (1) visitor per day
- Adult outpatient and clinic patients are allowed one (1) guest per appointment
- No visitors are allowed for patients under isolation protocols

## Visitor Restrictions – Pediatric Patients

- Pediatric hospitalized patients are allowed two (2) visitors per day
- Pediatric outpatients and clinic patients are allowed two (2) guest per appointment
- No visitors are allowed for patients under isolation protocols
